1. Castillo de Betera, Tinto (Valencia, Spain)

Produced in the warm Valencia region, this wine is fresh and full of bright berry fruits and subtle spice.

2. Vollandas, Merlot (Central Valley, Chile)

Easy drinking red, packed with jammy fruits and plum flavours, medium bodied with a soft rounded finish.

Typical deep ruby red wine, soft tannins and smooth on the palate, swirling with almonds and black berry fruit.

Wonderfully aromatic with wild bramble fruits, on the palate there is an explosion of blueberry and spiced raspberry fruits, good structure and long finish.

Produced in New South Wales, a medium to full bodied red with a gorgeous blend of spice and steeped berry fruit with a long, warming finish.
